

DIRK'S CORNER

What a great year this has been. Our job developers are very busy and job placements are at the highest level to date. We have already placed 54 job seekers in our community this year. Since this is our main mission, area channel partners like Disability Advocates of Kent County are referring jobseekers to us. With nearly 38,000 students with disabilities in our Kent County school system, our continued growth is inevitable.

We are serving a full house in the B26 Document Shredding program. 30+ jobseekers work in that program in Grandville and Grand Haven locations with 4 supervisors and 10-15 volunteers assisting. Grand Haven has plenty of documents to keep their crew busy, but Grandville location needs more documents. If you know of a business that would be willing to send their documents our way, that would be a blessing.

Pew Busters will launch by serving Brookside CRC with light housekeeping duties for our crew of 4 jobseekers and their supervisor. We want to grow this program to serving 3-4 more churches in 2024. We have been sending letters to area churches offering this service. We are not charging the church but instead we ask for a short presentation for awareness and current needs at Beyond26. Church referrals are appreciated!

We are entering the giving season. I hope you will consider your best gift for Beyond26. Our growth is going to require a bigger budget in 2024 and beyond. I want to thank each one of our supporters whether that was through prayers, volunteer hours or gifts. God has blessed us to be able to grow this wonderful nonprofit! What a blessing!
